

## NERVE GOES TO:

1 C	Blood supply to the head, the pituitary gland, the scalp, bones of the face, the brain itself, inner and middle ear, the sympathetic nerve system, all ascending and descending tracts and fibers.
2 C	Eyes, optic nerves, auditory nerve, sinuses, mastoid bones, tongue, forehead.
3 C	Cheeks, outer jaw, face bones, teeth, tri-facial nerves.
4 C	Nose, lips, mouth, eustachian tube.
5 C	Vocal cords, neck glands, pharynx.
6 C	Neck muscle, shoulders, tonsils.
7C	Thyroid gland, bursa in the shoulders, the elbows.
1 T	Arms from the elbows down, including the hands, wrists and fingers, also the esophagus and trachea.
2 T	Heart including its valves, and covering, also coronary arteries.
3T	Lungs, bronchial tubes, pleura, chest, breast, nipples.
4 T	Gall bladder and common bile duct.
5 T	Liver, solar plexus, blood.
6 T	Stomach.
7 T	Pancreas, Islands of Langerhans, duodenum.
8 T	Spleen, diaphragm.
9 T	Adrenals of supra-renals.
10 T	Kidneys.
11 T	Kidneys and ureters.
12 T	Small intestines, fallopian tubes, lymph circulation.
1 L	Large intestine or colon, inguinal rings.
2 L	Appendix, abdomen, upper leg, cecum.
3 L	Sex organs, ovaries or testicles, uterus, bladder, knee.
4 L	Prostate gland, muscles of the lower back, sciatic nerve.
5 L	Lower legs, ankles, feet, toes, arches.
Sacrum	Hip bone, buttocks, rectum, anus.
